

Calvary Kids (PRE-K – 6th Grade) will be RE/LAUNCHING Sept. 13th but only during the 11:00am service.

There will be no Infant or Toddler rooms open at this time. Due to COVID-19, there are some very important protocols that we have put into place to help provide a safe kid's ministry environment for children and families attending services at Calvary Lighthouse. Parents/Guardians please help us by reviewing the list of protocols provided below. These protocols are for everyone's safety!

Protocols for participating in Calvary Kids:

- We ask that parents/guardians please check temperatures before leaving home. Should you or your child have a temperature **above 100 °F**, we ask that you please remain home and join our online service.
- ***Please stay home should you or your child have symptoms of a cold*** such as runny nose, cough, sneezing, sore throat, body aches/soreness, or fever (in the last 24 hours). We understand that allergies can be an issue for many kids, just simply let us know if your child has seasonal allergies.
- ***There will only be 1 Check-in Station*** which will be located in Building C Sanctuary Foyer. All children are to be check-in at our Building C Check-Station. There will be no Child Check-In Station in the Joy Center (1st-6th) at this time. Kids 1st-6th can head over to the Joy Center once they have been checked in.
- Everyone visiting or participating in Calvary Kids will be required to have their temperature checked and complete a COVID Questionnaire.
- ***Should anyone arrive at Calvary Kids check-in having a temperature above 100 °F, they will not be permitted to go in the Calvary Kids Ministry areas and will be invited to please participate in our online service.***
- When you arrive, our volunteers will assist you in getting your children checked in and point you in the right direction.
- All children (above the age of 2) and adults are asked to wear a mask coming in, moving through rooms/spaces, and going out of Calvary Lighthouse facilities.
- Children will be expected to social distance while in classrooms but will not be required to wear a mask while stationary.
- During our time together on Sundays, Calvary Kids will be going through the same lessons that are provided on our Calvary Kids Facebook Group. This gives those who are unable to participate in person an opportunity to follow along with us through each series.
- ***We ask that the same Parent/Guardian who checked in a child also check-out their child.***
- At check-in everyone entering Calvary Kids will be given a temperature check sticker. This will help volunteers know who has or has not had their temperature checked.

Parents/Guardians, we are all about safety, however, we totally understand that children will be children. These are very unusual and challenging times for our kids. It is so very important to Calvary Lighthouse that they feel safe, connected, and loved while with us on Sundays. We are so excited for the opportunity to minister to kids again in person and are working hard to provide a safe and fun kid's ministry experience!

As we prepare to meet in-person, please help us by talking with your child/children about the importance of wearing a mask, social distancing, and good hygiene (washing hands often). Thank you so much!!
